SOLEMNITY OF PENTECOST – Today we celebrate this beautiful feast of the Holy Spirit. We recall the manifestation of the fulfillment of the Lord's assurance that He would send the Holy Spirit to inspire and protect His Church. It is also sometimes called the "birthday of the Church" since her missionary efforts began following the manifestation of the Holy Spirit.

MEMORIAL DAY MASS SCHEDULE – Monday, May 29

- A reminder that there is only one scheduled Mass in English at 10:00am on the following holidays: Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day (bilingual). On these four holidays the rectory office is closed and the church will be opened around 9:00am and closed shortly after the Mass. These are beautiful days to celebrate the Eucharist and pray for our country.

CORPUS CHRISTI is celebrated this year on Sunday, June 11. We will have a Corpus Christi Procession after the 1pm Mass beginning at approximately 2pm. Please join us for this public expression of faith in the True Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist.

CONFIRMATION - The Sacrament of Confirmation will be administered by Father Joel Henson, Associate Vicar for Clergy on Sunday, June 4 at the 5:30pm Mass. Please pray for our high school students and adults who will receive the Sacrament that evening. You are invited to attend the Mass as well.

CONGRATULATIONS FIRST COMMUNICANTS –

Yesterday, the children from the Religious Education Program of our parish received their First Holy Communion. Congratulations and may God bless all of them! On April 22th, the children from the Parish School received their First Holy Communion. Please keep all of them in your prayers.

FEAST OF ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA is June 13, our patronal feast day. Our Mass Schedule this year will be 6:30am, 8:00am, and 10:00am. The school children and staff will attend the 10:00am Mass. The traditional blessing of St. Anthony's Bread and St. Anthony's Lilies will take place at 10:00am Mass. Bread rolls will be provided by the Artiano Family although you may bring your own. Lilies will not be provided but you may bring your own for this blessing.

June 13 falls on a Tuesday this year. In preparation for his feast, we are asking all our parishioners to pray the novena prayers to him on the nine days preceding his feast. The novena begins on June 4 but you can begin your nine-day novena anytime. A copy of novena prayers in both English and Spanish can be found on a tab on the right side of our parish website. Please pray for your parish and its future during the novena. In 2021, we added the novena prayers to the end of the 8:00am Mass each Tuesday. Tuesdays and 13 (the date of his death and birthday into heaven in June 1231) are associated with devotion to St. Anthony. Thus the 13 Tuesdays Novena and the 13 Day Novena. There is also a custom for the 9 Tuesdays Novena and, of course, the 9-day novena.

DID YOU KNOW? - Keep talking about online activity -

También hay una costumbre para la novena de los 9 martes y, por supuesto, la novena de los 9 días.
