This feast recalls the mystery of our Lady's privilege of being taken up, body and soul, into heaven at the end of her earthly life. REFLECTION ON THE ASSUMPTION OF THE VIRGIN

MARY - "On 1 November 1950, Venerable Pope Pius XII proclaimed as Dogma that the Virgin Mary 'having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory'. This truth of faith was known by Tradition, was affirmed by the Fathers of the Church, and was a particularly important aspect in the veneration of the Mother of Christ. . . The Assumption reminds us that Mary's life, like that of every Christian, is a journey of following, following Jesus, a journey that has a very precise destination, a future already marked out: the definitive victory over sin and death and full communion with God, because as Paul says in his Letter to the Ephesians the Father "raised us up with him, and made us sit with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus" (Eph 2: 6). This means that with Baptism we have already fundamentally been raised and are seated in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, but we must physically attain what was previously begun and brought about in Baptism. In us, union with Christ resurrection is incomplete, but for the Virgin Mary it is complete, despite the journey that Our Lady also had to make. She has entered into the fullness of union with God, with her Son, she draws us onwards and accompanies us on our journey." – Pope Benedict XVI

REFLEXIÓN SOBRE LA ASUNCIÓN DE LA VIRGEN

MARÍA - "El 1 de noviembre de 1950, el Venerable Papa Pío XII proclamó como Dogma que la Virgen María 'habiendo completado el curso de su vida terrena, fue asumida en cuerpo y alma a la gloria celestial'. Esta verdad de fe fue conocida por la Tradición, fue afirmada por los Padres de la Iglesia y fue un aspecto particularmente importante en la veneración de la Madre de Cristo. . . La Asunción nos recuerda que la vida de María, como la de todo cristiano, es un camino de seguimiento, seguimiento de Jesús, un camino que tiene un destino muy preciso, un futuro ya marcado: el definitivo victoria sobre el pecado y la muerte y plena comunión con Dios, porque como dice Pablo en su Carta a los Efesios, el Padre "nos resucitó con él, y nos hizo sentar con él en los lugares celestiales en Cristo Jesús" (Ef 2, 6) . Esto significa que con el Bautismo ya hemos resucitado fundamentalmente y estamos sentados en los lugares celestiales en Cristo Jesús, pero debemos alcanzar físicamente lo que se inició y se llevó a cabo previamente en el Bautismo. En nosotros la unión con Cristo resurrección es incompleta, pero para la Virgen María es completa, a pesar del camino que también tuvo que hacer Nuestra Señora. Ha entrado en la plenitud de la unión con Dios, con su Hijo, nos atrae y nos acompaña en nuestro camino ". - Papa Benedicto XVI

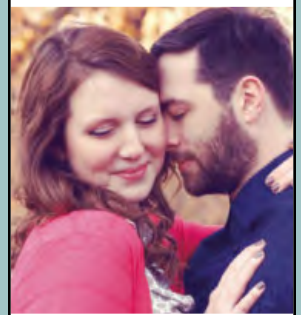
