Baptism/Bautismo

Baptisms: Infant Baptisms in English are held twice a month. Parents and Godparents must visit the Parish Office (Rectory) during office hours to:

- Register for the required Baptism Formation Seminar
- Submit a copy of the child's state-issued birth certificate

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION ON AUGUST 30 – Our weekly Eucharistic Holy Hour usually begins at 6:15pm and ends at 7:15pm. On First Fridays and Holy Days of Obligation that fall on Fridays, we begin with a bilingual Mass followed by the Holy Hour. There are four to eight times a year in which Arbor or Stone to Flesh sponsor an extended Eucharistic Adoration. Arbor will sponsor one of these on **Friday, August 30 from 6:15pm to 8:15pm.**

LABOR DAY MASS SCHEDULE –Monday, **Sept. 2nd** is Labor Day. The parish and school offices will be closed in observance of this civic holiday. Please note that there will be only one Mass celebrated that day at 10:00am. A reminder that there is only one scheduled Mass at 10:00am on the following holidays: Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day. On these four holidays the **church and parking lot will be opened around 9:00am and closed shortly after the Mass.** These are beautiful days to celebrate the Eucharist and pray for our country.

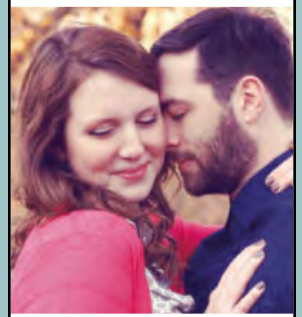
