

LENT – The holy season of Lent has begun. Below you will find the regulations of the Church regarding fast and abstinence. Please read them carefully. Last week's bulletin contained numerous suggestions for various Lenten practices. They can be found at a link in the upper righthand corner of our parish website, www.saintanthonygardena.org . Please read them carefully and decide how you want to strengthen your spiritual life this year. Lent is truly a privileged time because it forces us to pause and reflect on how we are living our lives and whether we need to make some adjustments, especially regarding our spiritual practices. There are three practices that are encouraged for everyone in our parish: regular Confession, frequent Mass (perhaps several times during the week) and weekly Stations of the Cross. Our Stations of the Cross each Friday are at 6:15pm in both English and Spanish followed by Eucharistic Holy Hour and Confessions. Come and pray with your parish family.

REGULATIONS FOR LENT

Abstinence and Fasting - Abstinence from eating meat is to be observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays during Lent. This applies to all people 14 and older. The law of fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday applies to all persons 18 or older and younger than 59. Fasting means that one full meatless meal per day may be eaten. Two other meatless meals may be taken sufficiently to maintain strength, but together they should not equal a full meal. Liquids, including milk and fruit juice, may be taken between meals. If health or ability to work is affected, fasting does not oblige. Private, self-imposed observance of fasting on Lenten weekdays is strongly recommended. Parents should ensure that children who are not bound by the laws of fast and abstinence are taught an authentic sense of penance, conversion, and reconciliation.

Lenten Observance - Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass and in the Sacrament of Penance during Lent, and parishes are encouraged to provide regular and frequent opportunities for such participation. Likewise encouraged are devotions such as Stations of the Cross, vigils and prayer services (with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, if opportune). Traditional practices - including increased prayer, Scripture and spiritual reading, alms, personal self-denial in food and drink, increased care, and service to the sick and needy - are also suggested.

Easter Duty - All initiated Catholics are bound by the obligations of receiving Communion at least once a year and the confers sacramentally all serious sine not proviously.

obligations of receiving Communion at least once a year and to confess sacramentally all serious sins not previously acknowledged in individual Confession. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter duty season, which is from the First Sunday of Lent until Trinity Sunday.

PRAYER, PENANCE AND CHARITY PROGRAM was enclosed in last week's bulletin and can be founded at a link in the upper righthand corner of our parish website: www.saintanthonygardena.org This program is a very practical, family-oriented way of encouraging growth in the spiritual life during our Lenten journey toward the great feast of Easter.

FRIDAY FISH FRY, STATIONS OF THE CROSS, HOLY HOUR, CONFESSIONS - The Knights of Columbus are hosting a Fish Fry every Friday during Lent. March 7th through April 11th, 5:00pm to 7:00pm. PRE-SALE Tickets: \$10.00 per plate. The price at the door is \$12.00. Tickets are sold by the Knights after all the Masses or purchased at the Rectory or School. Our Stations of the Cross each Friday begin at 6:15pm in both English and Spanish. (After 6:15pm Bilingual Mass on First Fridays.) They are followed by Eucharistic Holy Hour and Confessions. Come and pray with your parish family.

HOLY YEAR OF JUBILEE ACTIVITIES - First, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles will join local Churches around the world in 24 Hours for the Lord. A church in each of the 20 deaneries of the Archdiocese will remain open for 24 hours for confession and prayer from Friday morning, March 28 through Saturday morning March 29. See https://www.hope.lacatholics.org/24-hours for the locations and schedules. St. Margaret Mary in Lomita will host for our deanery and is the closest parish on the list to us.

Second, on Saturday, April 5, the Church will take to the streets of Los Angeles on a seven-mile **Pilgrimage of Hope**. The walk to the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels will begin at 8:00am at All Souls Church in Alhambra, with stops at Our Lady of Guadalupe, Rose Hill and Our Lady Help of Christians. Upon arrival at the cathedral, Archbishop Gomez will celebrate Mass; bus transportation from the cathedral to All Souls will be available at 1:00pm. The relics of several saints, including the soon to be canonized Bl. Carlo Acutis, will accompany us on our journey.

ALPHA is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith. Each talk looks at a different question about faith and is designed to create conversation. No matter where you are in your faith journey, everyone is welcome. Alpha is offered by thousands of parishes around the world, endorsed by Catholic Bishops and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Focusing on the kerygma-the initial proclamation of the Good News-Alpha introduces us to an encounter with Jesus. St. Anthony parishioners who have participated in past Alpha programs say that it has deepened their relationship with Jesus and connected them to new friends in our church community through food, inspiring talks, and good conversation. We invite you to take this next step where you get to walk with Jesus over these seven weeks, as you come to know more about who Jesus is for you and your life. Alpha will be held on 7 Mondays from March 3 through April 14 from 7:00pm-8:45pm at the parish hall.

So, it is important to talk to your children about when it is appropriate and when it is not to use a camera and how they should think about sharing images they take. Any image they send is shared permanently, and they cannot get those images back. If someone asks your child for an inappropriate photo, he or she should notify a trusted adult immediately. 
